PRINCIPAL OBIECTIVE:

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Implements Pi Phi's social media strategy for multiple social media accounts by generating, editing, publishing and sharing engaging content—including TikToks and Reels—as outlined by the social media calendar.
- Works closely with the marketing team to develop, execute and measure the results of digital marketing campaigns within budget and time constraints.
- Communicates with followers, responds to queries in a timely manner and monitors social engagement.
- Stays up to date with current technologies and trends in social media, design tools and applications.
- Assists in the writing of compelling, informative, search-engine optimized content for website and keeping all sections of the website up to date.
- Writes and edits content for publications, emails and blogs.
- Coordinates Pi Phi's email marketing efforts executing requests, facilitating testing prior to distribution and evaluating results afterward.
- Manages Pi Phi's Resource Library process including maintaining and updating educational materials and communicating updates.
- Collaborates with the Marketing team to ensure compliance with brand standards and consistency in Pi Phi's desired messages.
- Other duties as assigned.
